

Due to a ceremony in Ver Sur Mer at 08.30 to lay the first stone for the new British memorial which will be attended by the President of France and the British Prime Minister there will be roads closures and security restrictions in the morning of the 6th June so ceremonies are not being held at the normal time

6th June 10.00 commemoration for the civilian victims in the Place Byrd

6th June 10.30 on the corner of the Avenue du Col. Harper and the D514 a ceremony for the 2nd Battalion Hertfordshire Regiment and the Royal Artillery. There will be one ceremony and a simultaneous wreath laying at the two monuments.

6th June 10.45 Place Winston Churchill ceremony for the 4/7th Royal Dragoon Guards and the 5th Battalion of the East Yorkshire Regiment. This will include the unveiling of two new memorial plaques which list the fallen from the 6th June.

9th June - Green Howards group will visit with about 50 persons, and ceremonies will stand on that day both at Ver-sur-Mer, the Paisty Vert 10h45 and later at Crépon at the Green Howards War Memorial at 11.45 The band of the Royal British Legion will play at both ceremonies.
